Letter from the CEO and Board Chair

Dear Friends,

The first Ronald McDonald House in Utah opened in 1988, filling its 13 rooms with families of children who were seriously ill or injured. Thirty-five years later we have expanded to serve many more families thanks to your remarkable generosity, love, and support of Ronald McDonald House Charities® of the Intermountain Area (RMHC®)! Thank you for helping us grow our mission to serve more families, and to serve them better. We were thrilled to celebrate our 35th Anniversary in honor of the families, donors, staff, and volunteers who have shared their love with this organization over three and a half decades.


In January of 2023, we were grateful to expand our Salt Lake City Ronald McDonald House with the addition of three new private family bedrooms, bringing our total guest rooms to 75. We also opened a new Ronald McDonald Family Room program on the 4th Level of Primary Children's Hospital in Salt Lake City to support families in their NICU and Oncology Units.

The numbers are incredible: Together, we were able to serve 9,250 pediatric patient families with 22,115 individual family members, with free lodging, food, and transportation to and from hospitals in 2023. Core volunteers and Adopt-A-Meal groups donated 25,974 hours of volunteer service. Together we provided 57,980 free meals at our Ronald McDonald House® and hospital-based Ronald McDonald Family Room® programs. In addition to meeting basic needs of lodging, food, and transportation, we offered joyful distractions, compassionate family centered care, skilled grief and mental health support, and connection to community resources.

This annual report not only sums up the past year's work; it also recognizes the generous donors who fuel our mission, the volunteers who give their time, and the patient families who inspire us. Every single gift of time, talent, and treasure—large and small—helped provide practical support and compassionate care for neonatal and pediatric patient families. We also offer our deepest gratitude to the committed volunteers and volunteer leaders serving on our board for their careful stewardship of our mission! Thank you to the dream team of RMHC professionals who brought our mission to life during the year with compassion and joy. Finally, we honor the families who kept moving forward with love, courage, and strength, right alongside their hospitalized child.

Together we are surrounding families with the support they need to be near and care for their seriously ill or injured children. Thank you for supporting this important mission.

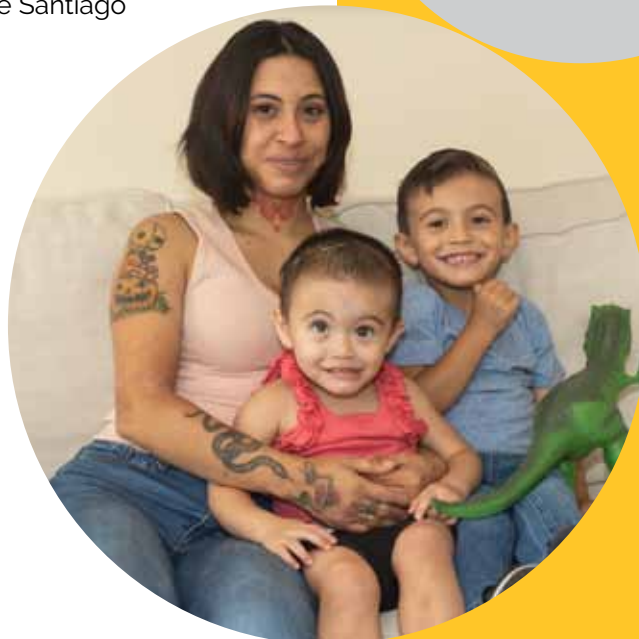

The Gross Family

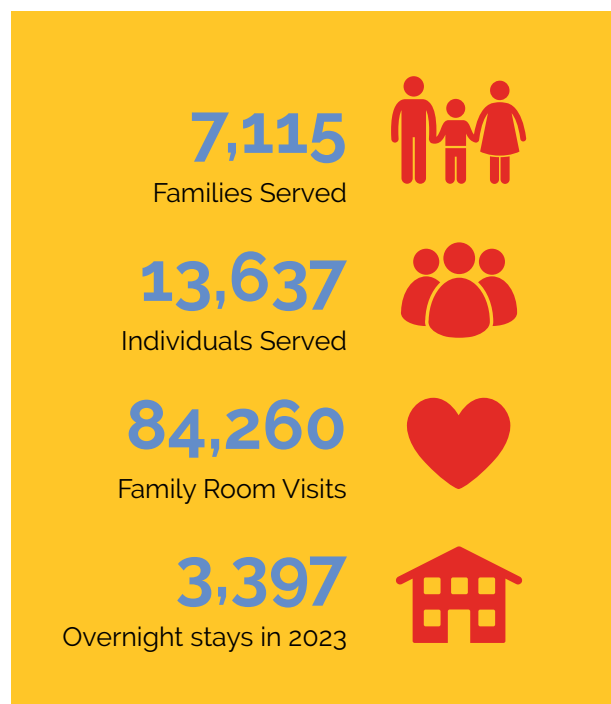

Ronald McDonald Family Rooms

We were thrilled to add a new Ronald McDonald Family Room on the fourth level of Intermountain Primary Children's Hospital in 2023. It serves the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, and the Pediatric Hematology, Oncology, and Cancer Units.

The 2nd Level Family Room at PCH serves parents with a child being treated in the Pediatric ICU, Neuro Trauma Unit, and Cardiac ICU. Our Family Room on Level 3 is available for families, children, and guests to visit together—it remains the largest Family Room across all chapters of Ronald McDonald House Charities.

We also have one Family Room located at the University of Utah Hospital (UofU), serving parents with a child in the Newborn ICU. Parents are steps away from their child being treated and can access showers, a combined thirteen overnight sleep rooms, kitchens equipped with grab and go snacks and meals, computers, crafts, and more.

Family Support Specialist

Maria Gamvroulas serves as RMHC's Family Support Specialist Manager. She helps provide a safe and welcoming space for families to seek deeper support during their stay at the Ronald McDonald House.

Her services include:

- Family-centered crisis intervention and mental health support for pediatric patient families from the Intermountain Area.
- Collaborative case management, referring families to additional resources locally and throughout the surrounding states.
- Assistance as families transition home, connecting them to community resources for food security, school, diagnosis-specific support groups, and diagnosis-specific financial resources.
- Skilled grief and bereavement support for families that experience the unimaginable loss of a child.

In 2020 RMHC partnered with the Cambia Health Foundation to begin a pilot program for a new Family Support Specialist Manager position to help address the complex challenges families with a seriously ill or injured child face in accessing medical care, with the emerging trends toward outpatient care. In 2021 the Cambia Health Foundation endowed the Family Support Specialist Manager position with a \$1.25 million grant.

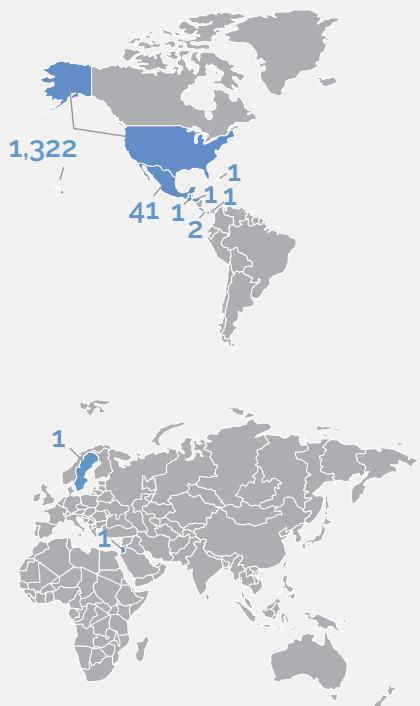
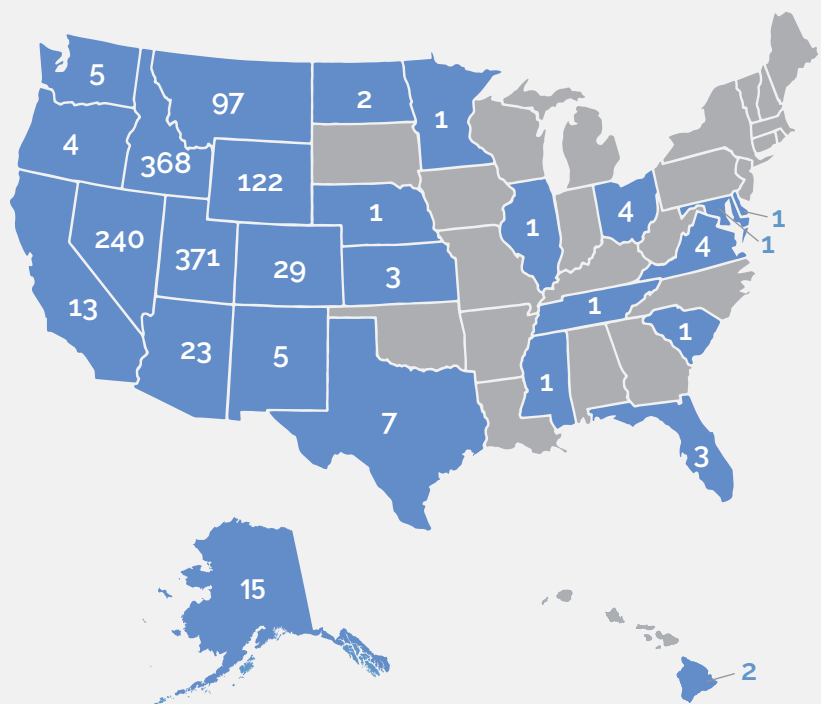

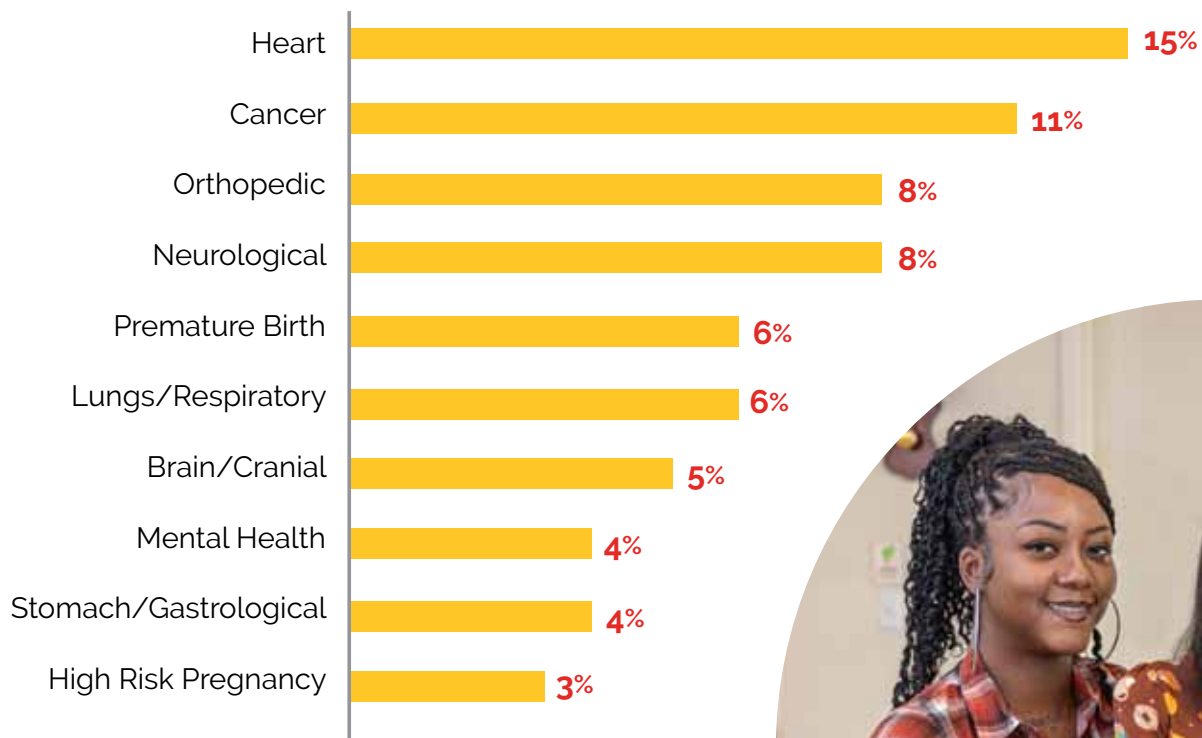

Top Diagnosis of Pediatric Patient Families Served

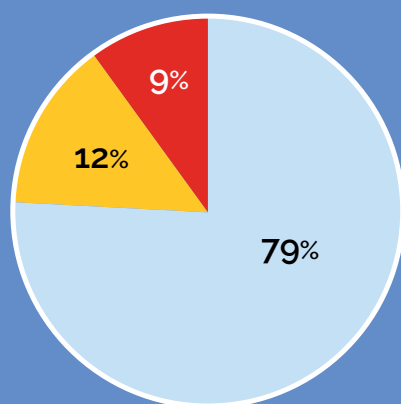

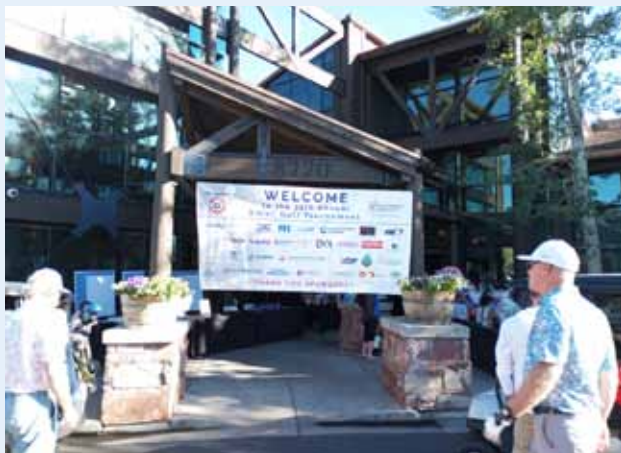

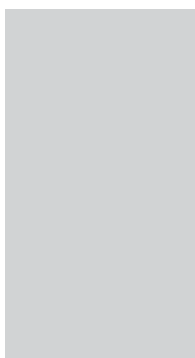

THE LEADING WITH LOVE CAMPAIGN

A Campaign to Expand, Enhance, and Sustain Mission Impact

The intermountain area has become a regional hub for specialized pediatric medical care. A growing population means more patients than ever are seeking life-changing and life-saving services here in Utah. In response, RMHC launched the Leading with Love Campaign to **EXPAND, ENHANCE,** and **SUSTAIN** our mission impact.

EXPAND MISSION IMPACT

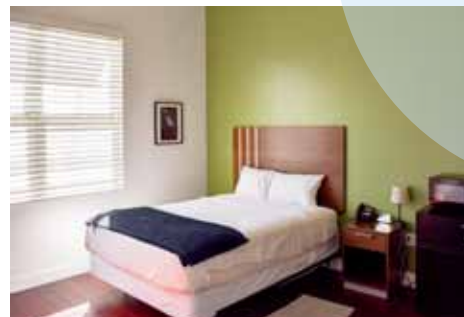
DECEMBER 2021—Added a new Ronald McDonald Family Room in University of Utah Hospital's Newborn Intensive Care Unit. This beautiful 1,800 square foot space includes a fully stocked kitchen, laundry, showers, two private sleep rooms, and more, serving an average of 1,500 families each year.



JANUARY 2023—Opened a new Ronald McDonald Family Room on Level 4 of Intermountain Primary Children's Hospital, adjacent to the Pediatric Oncology and Newborn Intensive Care Units. Its 1,300 square feet include two private sleep rooms, a fully stocked kitchen, laundry, showers, and spaces for families to rest as their children receive cancer treatments.



MARCH 2023—Added three overnight guest rooms to our Ronald McDonald House in Salt Lake City. With an increased capacity of 75 rooms, the House now provides an additional 1,095 nights for 150 additional families each year.



MARCH 2024—Expanded into Utah County with a new Ronald McDonald Family Room at Intermountain Primary Children's Hospital on the Larry H. and Gail Miller Family Campus in Lehi. Our family-centered services will help over 3,000 families each year, providing access to four private sleep rooms, a fully stocked kitchen, laundry, showers, and more.

COMING IN 2025—Our expansion continues next year with a new Ronald McDonald Family Room at the Wasatch Canyons Behavioral Health Campus of Intermountain Primary Children's Hospital. In light of Utah's adolescent mental health crisis, this space will serve an estimated 2,000 families each year with its kitchenette, showers, two private sleep rooms for naps or overnight stays, and more.

ENHANCE MISSION IMPACT

In addition to providing new physical spaces, we are enhancing our service to families with new programs that offer more emergency medical housing, nourishing meals, transportation to and from hospitals, utilities, and other supportive services. We will also add three permanently endowed staff positions:

- Two Family Support Specialists who provide pediatric patient families with skilled mental health support, case management, and access to community resources to address basic needs and support systems.
- One Chaplain to help address grief, bereavement, and provide inclusive spiritual care for pediatric patient families in crisis.



SUSTAIN MISSION IMPACT

RMHC's leadership takes a long view of the organization's mission impact. We are committed to growing our operating reserve to demonstrate responsible stewardship, ensure long-term sustainability for program growth, and help sustain core operations as we serve more pediatric patient families now and into the future.
